An Interview with Kevin Neal, CEO of P3iD Technologies, Inc.

P3iD Technologies is a new TWAIN Working Group Board Member company. P3iD's participation will be instrumental in the further development of TWAIN Direct's TWAIN Cloud security.

We sat down with Kevin recently, to get his thoughts on becoming a member of the TWAIN Working Group and how P3iD can contribute to TWAIN Direct's development.

Q: What was your motivation for joining the TWAIN Working Group?

A: Having P3iD join the TWAIN Working Group was an absolute no-brainer decision for us to join with a focus on TWAIN Direct. P3iD is an experienced team of industry professionals that have lot of real-world industry perspective in the document scanner hardware, recognition software and cloud-services markets. So we understand the value of our industries solutions to improve business efficiencies, yet we also fully

well-know there are issues with document scanning technology moving too slowly to truly adopt modern cloud computing solutions.

We see TWAIN Direct as an answer to many of these issues, and especially with the vision of a PC-less architecture. However, a web services scanning specification such as TWAIN Direct is only one part of the overall solution and additional capability such as enterprise authentication with Active Directory, document encryption and other cybersecurity-related items will be required. With P3iD's unique perspective from both the document scanning market, as well as our focus on cybersecurity, we are very motivated to join the TWAIN Working Group to advance the TWAIN Direct project forward quickly.

Q: How do you view TWAIN with regard to the scanning industry? How has TWAIN affected the scanning industry in your opinion?

A: More than ever TWAIN, and TWAIN Direct specifically, will absolutely play a much greater role in the scanning industry because of three obvious mega-trends of mobile, cloud and web services. These three mega-trends are closely related but each has to be carefully architected based on the specific use case and problems being solved.

Additionally, organizations are going away from proprietary technologies more often, so open source with interopability, really is resonating within the industry. Software developers have a desire to integrate with modern web services standards so that they can have flexibility in their architectural design, and for this reason TWAIN is a more appealing option than ever for creating truly innovate document scanning and capture solutions.

Q: What will be P3iD's role as part of the group?

A: P3iD has deep expertise in cybersecurity technologies so our role will be to assist the group in understanding and delivering resources specifically around Identity and Access Management (IAM). The first specification P3iD is going to assist the group with is specifically the SAML 2.0 protocol.

SAML 2.0 is an industry standard for sharing a common user identity among various third-party services. So, in the true spirit of the TWAIN Working Group to offer the widest range of interoperability, we feel the a solid understanding with good developer resources to implement SAML 2.0, without having to become an IAM expert, will be extremely valuable to the group.

Q: How do you think the new TWAIN Direct standard will change things?

A: At P3iD we have seen the vision on how TWAIN Direct will change things with mobile and a greater mashup of cloud services for a long time. However as an industry it's hard to imagine innovation without seeing it in-action with a prototype. So let me provide one example. One thing we see as rather obvious is driving the document scanning experience via pulling FROM a mobile device instead of pushing TO a mobile device.

This simply has to happen because nearly all the newer model document scanners on the market are coming with very small screens, or no screen at all. Therefore, how can a software application provide obvious things such as a username/password login authentication without a screen? Or how can you preview the scanned images on these small screens? As users struggle with authentication and image preview, the industry will finally begin to understand why pulling FROM a mobile device will eventually be the new standard in the document scanning industry.
